Tombola History and Traditions: In Italy tombola is a very common family game played at Christmas, and is similar to Bingo. In Italy at Christmas Eve, playing Tombola is a must, with all the relatives united around grandparents and small children shouting when they win a prize. Modern Tombola cards are in plastic and have small plastic slots over the numbers that can be closed down when the number is called, but traditionally the numbers were covered by fagioli (beans) or by pieces of orange peel from oranges you ate while playing. Each number represents something.
